3 Default Strategies for **Enterprise Print Management**

1 MANUAL INSTALLATION

Typically, Windows print drivers are installed one at a time.

You have to go to the desktop or laptop, connect it to your printer, go into your settings, and choose to install the print driver manually. Sometimes, the printer comes with a driver CD that you need to input into the computer to install the printer.

This process is the most basic option for installing and managing printers, but it doesn't scale well, and it certainly isn't easy to manage as your business grows.

The more users you have working at your enterprise, the less realistic, convenient, and cost-effective this solution becomes. It takes too much time away from IT admins themselves, and it can take too much time away from the users who need to complete their day-to-day tasks. fective solution for your business.

2 GROUP POLICY OBJECTS (GPOs)

A GPO is a collection of predefined commands that enables you to centralize and automate some key IT management tasks across multiple user accounts.

GPOs allow you to manage a variety of different computer settings and functions, including password policies, security settings, and

application settings, as well as enterprise printer assignment.

However, because GPOs involve managing so many different features, this approach can become unwieldy for enterprise IT managers.

Additionally, processing time can become an issue; GPOs can cause delays of up to 30 minutes in the user login process — for enterprise businesses who can't lose momentum on their day-to-day processes, that's an unacceptable amount of time to wait.

3 SCRIPTING

Print scripting is an approach to print management where IT admins write and deploy segments of code that run with every print job.

Although print scripting allows for greater customization in the types of commands and print policies you use, this approach can become difficult to manage as your business scales.

Managing your printers with a 2,000-line script may technically work, but script of that length can take hours to upkeep and manage, and the processing time increases with every line you add.
